## 2018 PUBLIC HEALTH SCHOLARSHIPS

**Graduate Students** seeking a degree in Public Health are encouraged to apply for an FPFA Scholarship. Scholarships include a \$150 award, presented at the 2018 FPFA Annual Conference, free registration to attend the 2018 FPFA Annual Education Conference, and a one-year student membership beginning July 2018. Active student members of FPFA are eligible to apply. Scholarship recipients must commit to serving on, and being active in, one interest group; and remain in Florida for at least one-year post graduation to contribute to Florida's Public Health System.

Applications must include:

- Narrative (1-2 pages) explaining professional goals and reasons for seeking Graduate Degree;
- Curriculum vitae;
- Two original letters of recommendation for this scholarship from 2 non-family (preferably faculty members) references;
- Copy of current transcript showing Grade Point Average.

**Undergraduate Students** seeking degrees in public health or health related programs are encouraged to apply for an FPFA Scholarship. Scholarships include a \$100 award, presented at the 2018 FPFA Annual Conference, free registration to attend the 2018 FPFA Annual Education Conference, and a one-year student membership beginning July 2018. The student does not need to be an FPFA member but must be nominated by an active member. Scholarship recipients will commit to actively serve on the Student Interest Group.

Applications must include:

- Narrative (1-2 pages) that explains professional goals and reasons for interest in health or public health;
- Curriculum vitae;
- Two original letters of recommendation for this scholarship from 2 non-family (preferably faculty members) references.
- Copy of current transcript showing Grade Point Average.
